Information for Judging/trophies



- Scooters that have won first place at previous SECC meets must be entered into the Sr. Classes.
- Scooters that have won first place in the Sr. Class cannot enter in any class again.
- All scooters must register and have picture taken before scooter(s) are put in the judging area.
- Aftermarket wheels and tires are acceptable only in the Custom and Modified classes.
- A Custom scooter is a Cushman scooter that has such things as non-Cushman paint, after market chrome, and any other non Cushman cosmetic changes.
- A Modified scooter is a Cushman scooter that has been mechanically modified by the addition of a Mikuni Carb, after market wheels and tires, an electric Start kit, or any other non Cushman two wheeled scooter modification.
- Show scooter judging is by people's choice. Each member and the member's spouse only is eligible to vote.
- Awards will be given in several classes for Cushman scooters. Classes are determined by the Board.

List of Classes

Class A – Barrel Spring Eagle; Class B – Early Eagle (mid-1955 thru 1958); Class C – Late Eagle ('59 and up flatheads); Class D – Silver Eagles; Class E – Early Step thru (thru '56); Class F – Later Step thru ('57 and up); Class G – All Cushman 3-wheelers (excluding Golfsters); Class H – All un-restored Cushman's (2 & 3 wheelers); Class I – All Cushman two wheeled scooters with non-Cushman Engine; Class J – Custom Cushman Eagles with Cushman engines; Class K – Modified Cushman Eagles with Cushman engines; Class L – Custom/Modified 3-wheelers excluding Golfsters; Class M – All Cushman Golfsters; Class N – All Sr. Cushman 2 wheelers; Class O – All senior 3 wheelers; Best of Show and Best Display.
